



Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Student Requirements

Students enrolling in the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program must complete the following requirements before the first day of class.

1. Multi-state criminal background check through Premier BioTech Criminal Background Services. Background checks take up to five days and cannot be expedited. Cost is \$43.01. The background screen will be delivered to TCL's Program Manager's secure portal.

2. To be submitted to TCL:
 - a. Copy of your current State ID
 - b. A completed TCL CNA Student Health Form. The form is available on TCL's CNA program webpage or by request. The form includes the following:
 - Quantiferon TB Blood Test
 - Proof of COVID vaccination/s
 - Proof of current Flu vaccination
 - A section of the form needs to be completed by a healthcare provider
3. Students must attend class in uniform. Uniform requirements:
 - a. Black scrubs.
 - b. White or black crewneck t-shirt.
 - c. Black clinical shoes. Shoes should have full foot coverage and be made of hard or soft leather or vinyl. No mesh or fabric shoes.
 - d. Black warm-up lab jacket with elastic ribbed cuffs. Jacket should zip or snap to the collar bone and should not have a lapel.
 - e. TCL student ID. TCL ID badge will be created after official registration.
