# **Nursing Application Checklist**

# Application Checklist

- My official TCL admission application is on file
   Note It is necessary to reapply if you have not attended classes at TCL for >1 year
- □ I have verified that <u>official</u> transcripts from <u>high school</u> (or GED) and <u>all colleges</u> previously attended have been received by TCL.

Note - It is the student's responsibility to follow-up with Student Records for transfer of credits

- □ I am eligible to take MAT 120 and BIO 210 *required prior to application to the program*
- My biophysical science course credits and mathematics course credits were completed within five years of application
- □ I have met with my Health Sciences Advisor within 6 months of application submission (Date \_\_\_\_\_\_)
- □ I have a letter of employment verification of 6 months or more in a healthcare setting, if applicable.

# **Application Requirements**

- **Pathway 1** Students who do not need the increased requirements under Pathway 2 or 3
  - □ I have achieved a 1300 or higher on the Achieve 3000
  - □ I have scored a 66 or higher (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS. The TEAS must be taken at the TCL Testing Center.
  - I have a technical GPA of 2.75 or higher
     Technical GPA is calculated using the highest scores for MAT 120, BIO 210, BIO 211, & BIO 225 within the last five years.
  - □ I have an institutional GPA of 2.25 or higher from the last college where 12 or more semester hours were completed (in addition to the technical GPA of 2.75 or higher)
- □ **Pathway 2** Required for applicants that have failures (D/F/WF) within the last three years in **two or more** required general education courses\*
  - □ I have achieved a 1300 or higher on the Achieve 3000
  - □ I have scored a 69 or higher (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS. The TEAS must be taken at the TCL Testing Center.
  - I have a technical GPA of 3.00
     Technical GPA is calculated using the highest scores for MAT 120, BIO 210, BIO 211, & BIO 225 within the last five years.
  - □ I have completed all required non-nursing courses in the program of study

Courses - BIO 210, 211, & 225, ENG 101 & 102, MAT 120, PSY 201 & 203, approved HUM (3 Hrs) Note – MAT and BIO courses must have been completed within the last five years

□ I have an institutional GPA of 2.25 or higher from the last college where 12 or more semester hours were completed (in addition to the technical GPA of 3.00 or higher)

\*This requirement stands for students with a D/F/WF in two or more <u>different</u> general education courses. However, if a student has 2 or more failures (D/F/WF) in the same required general education course, the student must have a passing grade in this course prior to application.

- □ **Pathway 3** Required for applicants that have two or more failures (D/F/W/WE/WP/WF) in Nursing courses within the last five years *Students only have one opportunity for re-admission* 
  - □ I have achieved a 1300 or higher on the Achieve 3000
  - □ I have scored a 73 or higher (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS. The TEAS must be taken at the TCL Testing Center.
  - I have a technical GPA of 3.00
     Technical GPA is calculated using the highest scores for MAT 120, BIO 210, BIO 211, & BIO 225 within the last five years.
  - I have completed all required non-nursing courses in the program of study
     Courses BIO 210, 211, & 225, ENG 101 & 102, MAT 120, PSY 201 & 203, approved HUM (3 Hrs)
     Note MAT and BIO courses must have been completed within the last five years
  - □ I have an institutional GPA of 2.25 or higher from the last college where 12 or more semester hours were completed (in addition to the technical GPA of 3.00 or higher)
  - □ I have waited a minimum of two academic years from the time of second failure to apply

#### **Acknowledgements**

I understand that if accepted into the program:

- □ I must maintain a TCL GPA of at least 2.25 to remain in program.
- □ I must attend the **entire mandatory orientation** and all required activities as stated in my acceptance letter.
- □ I must have access to a computer, Webcam, microphone, and internet as all nursing courses have an online component.
- □ I must be able to attend clinical rotations at sites within a 60—mile radius of the Beaufort campus, which may include weekend and evening rotations. I understand clinical placement cannot be customized to student preference.
- □ I must be eligible and able to attend all clinical sites utilized by the Nursing program. Clinical clearances are determined by the clinical facilities, not TCL.
- □ I will be required to provide updated health information and complete clinical information for various agencies at admission and throughout the program.
- □ I will be required to attend Nursing classes at the Beaufort campus, as not all Nursing classes are offered at the New River campus.
- □ I will be required to complete a drug screen and background check. If I have concerns about results that may be present on my background check, I must schedule a meeting with the Dean of Health Sciences upon receiving my acceptance letter.
- □ I will be required to provide documentation of valid health insurance for the duration of the program.
- □ I must maintain valid AHA BLS certification for the duration of the program.
- □ Requirements for the program are subject to change without notice in order to meet requirements of the South Carolina LLR Board of Nursing, the South Carolina Technical College System, and ACEN.
- □ The ability to receive licensure by NCLEX examination may be contingent upon United States citizenship.
